ROOSTER CUP

The ice skating club of Meudon is pleased to announce the « Rooster cup », an international competition for Advanced novice with short and free program (girls, boys and pairs), with Juniors, Cubs and Chicks. Please note that for minor categories a separate Announcement is available as « Lakes Trophy Cup » Interclub competition.

This competition will take place on the [ice rink of UCPA Sport Station Meudon](#) April 4, 5 & 6 2026.

I.1 GENERAL REGULATIONS

The « Rooster cup 2026 » will be conducted in accordance with the ISU Constitution and General Regulations 2024, the Special Regulations & Technical Rules Single & Pair Skating 2024, and the relevant ISU Communications, or any updates published by the date of the commencement of the event.

Participation in Rooster Cup is open to all Competitors who belong to an ISU Member, and qualify with regard to eligibility according to the ISU Rules in effect. All participants' ages must fall within the limits specified in the ISU Rules and they must meet the participation, citizenship and residency requirements in the ISU Rules & Communications in effect or any updates published at the time of the commencement of the competition.

Passports of all Skaters, as well as the ISU Clearance Certificate, if applicable, must be presented at the accreditation of the event for verification.

All competitors must be entered through their respective ISU Member Federation.

I.2 SPORTITY APP

The Sportity-app can be downloaded via Google Playstore or Apple app store. All relevant competition information will be published on the App (incl. Entries & Results).

There will be information boards on site and but all participants are kindly asked to use the app.

III.1 ENTRIES OF COMPETITORS

The Advanced Novice Competitors must be entered through their respective Member Federation with a maximum of three (3) skaters per category. For the French Clubs the entries will be by FFSG, CSNPA or Invitation.

With the online entry the “Program Content Sheet” must also be filled out in the ISU Portal. It is not permitted to hand over the Program Content Sheets directly to the acting Officials.

Please note that the « Inter-clubs-Lakes Trophy », will take place at the same time. Details are stated in a separate announcement.

III.2 ENTRIES BY NAME

The Entries by names must be made via the ISU Online Registration System (ORS): <https://fsk-ors.isu.swisstiming.com> no later than **March 6th 2026 - 20:00 h (CET)**.

The organizing committee reserve the right to limit the entries up to a maximum allowed.

III.2.1 ENTRIES OF JUDGES

Each participating ISU Members may nominate one international / ISU (1) judge and one substitute Judge.

The Entries of Judges must be done through the ORS no later than **March 6th 2026**.

OC will provide and cover the expenses for rooms and meals for all nominated judges from ISU Members, except travel costs who will be covered by ISU Member.

In case of too many nominated judges the organizer will draw the panel of judges immediately after the closing date for the entries. The result of such draw will be communicated to all ISU Members involved in writing immediately after the conclusion of such draw.

Each panel of Judges will consist of at least 5 Judges.

III.3 ENTRIES FEES

- Advanced Novices: 95€
- Advanced Novices pairs: 105€ per pairs

- Entry fee will be refunded if the skater is not accepted (if there will be a limitation of the numbers of entries).

VII – ACCREDITATION

The official accreditation for Teams is planned at the “UCPA Sport Station Ice Rink” upon arrival.

VIII - RESULTS AND DRAW

Judging and calculations will be done according to ISU Special Regulations Single & Pair Skating, Rules 352 and 353.

There will be no draw after the first segment. Starting orders, for the second segment will be according the reverse of the results of short programs.

VIII.1 - AWARDING CEREMONY

The first three best placed Competitors in each event will be announced and honored. Trophies and Gifts will be presented to the medalists. The national anthem of the winner will be played.

Each Skater will receive a medal in the kiss and cry after her/his performance.

IX - INITIAL JUDGES MEETING / ROUND TABLE DISCUSSION

The initial Judges meeting and the Technical panel meeting will be held at the ice rink Friday evening, April 3rd 2026. The exact times will be announced by the referee and Technical Controller . Round Table Discussions will be held Sunday and Monday.

X - INSURANCE / LIABILITY

In accordance with Rule 119, it is the sole obligation of each Member participating in ISU Events, to provide medical and accident insurance for their athletes, officials and all other members of the Member's team. Such insurance must assure full medical attendance and also the return of the ill or injured person to the home country by air transport or by other expeditious.
